

You are required to select nine (9) semester-length elective subjects following the guidelines outlined below. You will be timetabled into eight of the options, which will be distributed across Semesters One and Two. Your ninth choice will serve as a reserve option.

- Your first preference must be a History option (Ancient History or Modern History).
- Your second choice must be one of the Science options (Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, or Physics).
- When selecting your remaining seven elective preferences (including your reserve option) please keep the following constraints in mind ...
 - If you intend studying French, Japanese and/or Music then you must select both of the courses offered in that subject. Exemptions may be negotiated in special circumstances.
 - You are limited to selecting a maximum of 3 courses from the available sciences, including the science chosen as your first preference;

All students will study English and Mathematics, Core PE, Religious & Values Education, and Personal Development. These will be automatically added to your timetable.

Important! If a subject is important for you, then place it high on your list of preferences before any less important subjects.
