

You are required to select five (5) semester-length elective subjects, which must include at least one semester of a language other than English. You will be timetabled into four of the remaining options over two semesters; the fifth preference will serve as a reserve option.

Preference 1 will be your choice of a mandatory, semester-length, language other than English (i.e. French 2 or Japanese 2). Your remaining four preferences, including your reserve option, will be selected from the following six options: Art, Drama, Music, Film Television & New Media, French 3, and Japanese 3.

- If you want to study French or Japanese for a whole year you must select *French 3* or *Japanese 3* as Preference 2, 3 or 4.
- If you want to study two languages for the whole year please consult with Mr Hooper before proceeding with your subject selections.

All students will study English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities, HPE, IDEAS, RAVE, and Personal Development. These will be automatically added to your timetable after your elective preferences have been received.

Important! If a subject is important for you, then place it higher on your list of preferences than any less important subjects.

Preference Group 1: A mandatory language other than English. Place the number '1' in the box next to your preferred option.
