### WEEK 1 – Monday April 8 – Friday April 12

**Monday - Cubbies, Forts and Box Play PLUS Small Wheels Day** (*No bikes please and don't forget NO HELMET = NO RIDE*)

Spend the morning hanging out with friends creating the ultimate chill space by using our array of resources to make cubbies and forts. The children will be able to ride their small wheels around the College or participate in a range of fun games.

**In the afternoon**, it's time for some board game fun. Please feel free to bring along a favourite board game from home or alternatively you can access our board games. Get into the Easter spirit and join Miss Lucy with bunny face painting.

**Tuesday – (Excursion) Benefit Health and Fitness at The Stables Mountain Creek** (Additional Charge \$30.00 / Family Suggestion) *Please be at school no later than 8:30am.*

Today we jump on board the bus travelling just down the road to Mountain Creek to get active at the CrossFit Kids Program which is meant to be *BIG fun for all ages*. The session will include fitness and mindfulness techniques. **Wednesday – (Incursion) Jump Force International Workshop** (Additional Charge \$10.00) - presented by Luke Boon, 28 times World Jump Rope Champion. Enjoy a jump rope workshop, learning skills with single ropes, long ropes and Double Dutch skills, partner skills and team building through interactive group games.

**In the afternoon**, we will have our **Sustainability Session** – create a reusable shopping bag (please bring in an old pillowcase for this activity), make a milk carton bunny herb planter or a DIY bird feeder to help bring the birds into your garden.

**Thursday – (Incursion) Soccer Clinic with Paul Arnison 9:00am-11:00am** (Additional Charge \$20.00) - Work with Paul and his team of coaches on your Soccer skills with plenty of ball dribbling exercises, shooting drills, fun games and other ball activities depending upon the individual's abilities.

**In the afternoon**, work in teams and participate in our Easter wool maze activity, or get cooking and make bunny cupcakes for afternoon tea; or relax with a Movie and chill out for the afternoon.

**Friday - Construction Day** - Today we will make, build, create and construct marshmallow structures, participate in a straw marble roll challenge, create the ultimate marble maze, make edible sculptures for afternoon tea or try the Easter egg tower challenge ... see if you defy gravity and much, much more.

**Lunch** – please bring in a share plate for a communal feast but *please be allergy aware*. We also strongly encourage healthy food choices.

**In the afternoon**, get involved with an Easter Egg Hunt around the Prep playground.

### WEEK 2 – Monday April 15 – Thursday April 18

**Monday - Colour Day** – today we explore colour in every way! Make sure you dress for success... there will be great prizes for the most colourful outfit. Today's fun and games will include crazy hair creations, airbrushed tattoos, rainbow nails, rainbow egg challenge, colour fun run team race, "m&m" colour sort challenge and rainbow food for afternoon tea. There will also be alternate activities available indoors and out.

**Tuesday – (Excursion) Something seems a little fishy today ...** (Additional Charge \$15.00) *Please be at school no later than 8:15*

Today we are going to jump on board the bus to explore beautiful Mooloolaba. We will start our day with the children having a guided tour of the Mooloolaba Fish Market and the Sunshine Coast Water Police HQ.

## PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

Our Vacation Care Programs are designed and developed in collaboration with the families, Educators' team and children that use the service. Our programs are based on an approved learning framework – My Time Our Place Framework for School Age Care, the developmental needs, interests and experiences of each child and take into account the individuality of each child.

Critical reflection and careful planning increase the value of children's time with us, by ensuring that the program and practice responds to children's interests and scaffolds learning (National Quality Standards). In developing Vacation Care programs, the service recognises the basis of the program aims to be recreation and leisure. The program and learning environments embrace "free choice" and "free play".

*Please note -*

- **CANCELLATION** Should parents wish to cancel their Vacation Care booking they are to contact the Coordinator on 5477 3257 directly the day before the child's attendance. *If parents give less than one day's notice then the full daily fee will be charged to your account.* Please be aware if you are cancelling for a Monday, notice must be provided to the service by close of business the week prior. The service requires at least 48 hours cancellation for attendance on an excursion day due to confirmation requirements to bus services and excursion locations. In this case, families will be charged the full daily rate including the additional charge for the day.
- **Fees:** *The daily fee is \$48.00 - 1 child, \$46.00 - 2 children, \$44.00 - 3 children;* excursion days do incur an extra fee which includes the activity and bus hire. Child Care Subsidy (CCS) is available through Centrelink in your *MyGov account*. These subsidies are also applied to all of our Additional Charges for incursions and excursions.
- Each day, children need to bring morning tea, lunch (healthy choices please) unless provided by OSHC (*this will be noted on the Vacation Care Program*), water bottle, sun smart hat and change of clothes for water days/messy days. We do request special toys from home and technology are ONLY bought in on the days allocated on the program. Please be mindful of what your child wears each day to OSHC when looking at the daily activities in which your child may participate. Closed in shoes are required at all times. In accordance with our Sun Smart Policy, strappy singlet tops and dresses are not to be worn.
- For excursions, children may be requested to wear a Matthew Flinders polo shirt (*this will be noted on the Vacation Care Program*). Please make sure that on excursion days, your child arrives at the service NO LATER than 8:30am or time specified on program. This ensures we have ample time to prepare to leave the College premises, catch the bus and arrive at the destination on time. Risk Assessments are completed for all incursions, excursions and activities undertaken throughout the program and are available to families upon request.
- If medication is to be administered during vacation care, please follow the College's policy outlined in the Family Information Package. Staff at Vacation Care will administer medication. Please also inform staff of any food allergies your child may have.
