OECD, 2023

By international standards, Australia has some of the most disruptive classrooms in the world. On the OECD's index of disciplinary climate, Australia ranked 70 out of 81 nations surveyed when it came to classroom discipline. (OECD, 2023)

USA = 28



Mhy engagement?

- Student engagement: "student's active participation in academic and cocurricular or school-related activities, and commitment to educational goals and learning".
- Student engagement was strongly associated with:
 - Academic Achievement (r = .33)
 - Subjective Wellbeing (r = .35)

Beonging matters

- Social connection is a fundamental human need, as essential to survival as food, water and shelter. (Murthy, 2022)
- The percentage of adults who have no close friends has increased from 36% to 54% in the last 20 years. (Way et al., 2018)
- The mortality impact of being socially disconnected is similar to that caused by smoking up to 15 cigarettes a day and even greater than that associated with obesity and physical inactivity (Way et al., 2018)
- Chronic loneliness and social isolation increase the risk of developing dementia by approximately 50%
- People are 4x more likely to report being lonely now, than in 1957.

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


- A tool is a specific technique that a teacher uses to manage the behaviour of students
- E.g., Proximity, Describe and Direct, Directed Choice, Take up Time
- A sequence of tools forms a routine. Our goal is to turn routines into habits over time.
- E.g. Defuse Debate




