PROGRAMS

U6 to Seniors (15years +) boys and girls teams.

SEASON DETAILS

The season runs from mid-March and typically ends mid-September.

Players compete in the Football Queensland Sunshine Coast club competition against clubs from across the Sunshine Coast. Games are usually held on a Saturday, with the younger players usually playing in the morning.

TRAINING

Training is held after school on the Flinders College campus under the guidance of coaches.

friendly and accomplished support staff and committee under the guidance of the Flinders Director of Coaching, former EPL player and current NPL coach, Paul Arnison. Additional specialist services are available for interested players.

FLINDERS NETBALL CLUB

Flinders Netball Club provides opportunities to Flinders students and the wider community to make sport accessible, enjoyable and challenging. The Club provides a supportive community to help participants develop their skills, character and networks.

PROGRAMS

Mixed gender teams cater for children ages 7 to 11.

Net Set Go for ages 7-10 years is a non-competitive version of the game.

Net Set Go Green/Gold for ages 7-8 years is a modified version to introduce young players to the game.

Net Set Go White for ages 9-10 years plays with full rules and scoring but no competition ladder.

Divisional Netball for ages 11-18 years is a skills-based competition (rather than aged-based) with grading at club and association level.

SEASON DETAILS

Competing in the Sunshine Coast Netball Association the Junior competition starts April 23rd with grading from mid March. The season runs for approximately 14 weeks. All games are played on



Saturday mornings at Maroochydore Multi Sports Complex on Fisherman's Road, Maroochydore.

TRAINING

Training is weekly starting Term 1. Most teams train before or after school on the Flinders College campus.

Teams play in weekend or weeknight-based Club competitions.

Club memberships are open to Flinders students and also the broader Sunshine Coast community

Players are registered through local/state/national association-based software, such as 'My Cricket', 'Rugby Xplorer', 'FFA', 'MyNetball', 'Clippers Basketball'

Flinders Clubs are managed by a committee of volunteers, led by an elected President

Clubs are able to recruit outside talent to bolster numbers and/or competitiveness

Teams play in predominantly Flinders 'navy and white' uniforms (wherever possible) with a logo identifying them as a club. The logo has the 'scratches' set in the background to indicate the presence of the Flinders Beast
