Role Summary

The role of the Property Services Manager, working under the general direction of the Capital Works and Facilities Manager, is to support the operational requirements of the College by being responsible for all aspects of the development, maintenance and presentation of campus buildings, grounds, sporting fields, turfs, sporting amenities, and gardens, for use by the College community, including visitors, parents, students and staff, and to actively promote a good first impression of the College to the general public.

Inherent in this position is the ability to do bending and heavy lifting of goods, safely handle organic and chemical pesticides and sprays, undertake maintenance of machinery and equipment, and legally operate a motor vehicle. These are regular routine tasks essential to the efficient and effective management of the Property Services Manager role. The Property Services Manager is expected to conduct the work in a safe manner.

Primary Relationships

- o Report directly to the Capital Works and Facilities Manager
- o Directly manage employees in the following positions and indirectly manage / oversee their subordinates (where relevant):
 - o Property Services Officer
 - o Head of Grounds
 - o Head of Maintenance
- o Work collaboratively with staff in other departments across the College
- o Liaise with Contractors and external suppliers, including Council

Working Hours

This position is required to work onsite full time for 38 hours per week. Reasonable additional hours may be required from time to time.

Main Responsibilities

Technical Expertise

- o Lead the operation of the Property Services Department and its staff.
- o Maintain and develop the preventative maintenance program in conjunction with the Capital Works and Facilities Manager.
- o Assist the Capital Works and Facilities Manager to plan, cost and develop minor or major works as required from time to time.
- o Maintain a current and accurate services plan of the location of utilities gas, water electricity, and telephone and computer network lines.
- o Oversee the repair, maintenance, and storage of all equipment including College vehicles, tractors, and ride-on mowers.
- o Supervise the development and maintenance of buildings, gardens, grounds, ovals, and turf wicket to a professional standard that will complement the environment and present a pleasant appearance.
- o Oversee the preparation of ovals for sporting events and carnivals including line marking and set up of equipment.
- o Lead the establishment and maintenance of pedestrian ways, service roads and other traffic areas around the College.

- o Manage the simplex lesson times changeover (bell) system.
- o Responsible for the daily security of the premises, in conjunction with the resident Caretaker.
- o Responsible for all fire services equipment and evacuation procedures, in consultation with the Workplace Health and Safety Officer.
- o Coordinate the timely distribution of goods throughout the College.
- o Manage the College key register.

Leadership

- o Schedule the workloads of the Property Services team to ensure the efficient and effective allocation of resources.
- o Provide leadership and direction to the Property Services team, enabling them to reach their full potential.
- o Ensure staff are accountable to the professional expectations of their positions and College policies and procedures.
- o Ensure the Property Services team are provided with training that supports compliance and their professional development.
- o Lead a culture of continuous improvement by keeping abreast of, and embedding contemporary and innovative grounds, gardens, maintenance and facilities management practices.

Occupational Health and Safety

- o Maintain a clean, tidy and highly presentable College buildings and grounds environment.
- o Ensure work is carried out in a safe manner having due regard for the health and safety of yourself, your fellow workers and all other users of the College grounds.
- o Provision of first aid services when required.
