

All Year 10 students will study English, Core HPE and, RAVE which are automatically added to your timetable.

You are required to select twelve (12) semester-length elective subjects following the guidelines outlined below. You will be timetabled into nine options, which will be distributed across Semesters One and Two. Your 10th, 11th and 12th choices may be timetabled where higher preferences cannot be accommodated.

- a. Your first preference must be one of the two Mathematics options (Preparatory General Maths or Preparatory Maths Methods)
- b. Your second preference must be one of the four Science options (Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics or Psychology).
- c. Your third preference must be one of the six Humanities electives (Ancient History, Modern History, Philosophy & Reason, Legal Studies, Economics or Geography)
- d. When selecting your remaining nine elective preferences (including your reserve options) please keep the following constraints in mind:
 - If you intend studying French, Japanese and/or Music, these subjects are full year courses. Exemptions may be negotiated in special circumstances for students to discontinue after completion of Semester One.

Important! If a subject is important for you, then place it high on your list of preferences.
