

You are required to nominate six elective courses and three reserve options to study in Years 11 and 12. When making your selections you must select:

- 1 x course from the English options;
- 1 x course from the Mathematics options; and
- 7 x courses from any of the learning areas listed in Preference Group 3.

All students will participate in Religious and Values Education, and Fit for Life, which will be automatically added to your timetable after your elective preferences have been received.

Important! If a subject is important for you, then place it higher on your list of preferences than any less important subjects.
